Gas Safe Register runs the register of legal gas engineers who are qualified to work with gas in the United Kingdom and Isle of Man.

All Gas Safe registered engineers carry an ID card showing the type of work they are qualified to do. Before any gas work is carried out always make sure you ask to see their Gas Safe Register ID card.

Landlords have responsibilities for gas safety. As a tenant it's important you're aware of them

Your landlord has to arrange for a gas safety check to be completed every 12 months.

Always:

- check the ID card of any gas engineer that comes to do work at your property
- co-operate with your landlord and let an engineer in whenever a gas safety check or maintenance is required
- make sure your landlord supplies you with a copy of the safety certificate within 28 days of it being carried out, or before you move in.

If you think a gas appliance is faulty turn it off and let your landlord know immediately. Poorly maintained, badly installed or faulty gas appliances could put you at risk of carbon monoxide poisoning. If you feel unwell seek medical help immediately and call the gas emergency helpline.

Gas Safe Register replaced the CORGI gas register in Northern Ireland on 1 April 2010.



Remember to check both sides of the ID card for:

- the licence number
- the start and expiry date
- the security hologram
- the work your engineer is qualified to do
- up-to-date qualifications.
